The GRAMMY® Award nomination in 2011 was for Best Country Performance by a Duo or Group with Vocals for "*Elizabeth*" from **Dailey & Vincent Sing the Statler Brothers**. The album debuted at #1 on Billboard's Bluegrass Music Chart and #19 on Billboard's Country Chart, earning the Hot Shot Debut and marking the duo's first Top-20 debut on the chart. It ranked #17 on the Billboard.com Top 50 Bluegrass Albums of 2011. The album also landed the #1 spot on the Heatseekers Albums Chart. Their 2011 SPBGMA Bluegrass Awards include Bluegrass Band of the Year, Entertaining Group of the Year, Album of the Year - **Dailey & Vincent Sing the Statler Brothers**, Vocal Group of the Year, Gospel Group of the Year/Contemporary and Male Vocalist of the Year/Contemporary - Jamie Dailey. And they earned the 2011 GMA Dove Award for Bluegrass Album of the year - **Singing From the Heart**. They were honored with 2010 International Bluegrass Music Awards for Entertainer of the Year, Vocal Group of the Year and Album of the Year - **Dailey & Vincent Sing the Statler Brothers**.
